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Elective courses provide more flexibility for students in choosing courses from a pool of options. Students shall pick preferred courses to meet certain ECTS Credit requirements (to gain a pre-specified amount of credits to graduate).

Students must choose a minimum of ten electives with (28-36 ECTS) which means $15 \%$ of the total ECTS Credit required for the graduation, the electives are as the followings:
> One Non-Technical Elective in the Fall Semester/ Frist Grade (with 3-4 ECTS).
$>$ One Non-Technical Elective in the Spring Semester/ Frist Grade (with 3-4 ECTS).
$>$ One Non-Technical Elective in the Fall Semester/ Second Grade (with 3-4 ECTS).
$>$ One Non-Technical Elective in the Spring Semester/ Second Grade (with 3-4 ECTS).
$>$ One Technical Elective in the Fall Semester/ Third Grade (with 4-5 ECTS).
$>$ One Technical Elective in the Spring Semester/ Third Grade (with 4-5 ECTS).
$>$ Two Technical Elective in the Fall Semester/ Fourth Grade (with 4-5 ECTS).
> Two Technical Elective in the Spring Semester/ Fourth Grade (with 4-5 ECTS).
